From Your COA Director:

Dear Ashby,

Did you know Ashby has a town nurse? It's true! Her name is Tamara Bedard and she recently paid a visit to your COA to talk about the services she provides to Ashby. On page 3 of this month's newsletter you'll see her photo and can read about her role in detail. I think it's worth me calling your attention to it and here's why: As your COA Director I wear many hats, but my number 1 priority is to respond to any Ashby senior that may have unmet needs and then connect that senior with people who can provide assistance and services to meet those needs. As you all know, seniors often have unmet medical needs and medical questions. Our town nurse, Tamara, is an invaluable resource for answering those questions and getting those needs met. I work closely with Tamara to make sure Ashby senior's medical needs are being met. Over the past few months, I've seen her answer Ashby seniors' questions about their medications, take a senior's blood pressure in their home, connect a senior with several in-home care providers to chose from, and simply stop by to check-in on a senior living alone (all with permission of course). Remember the days when the town Doctor would come to your home? That type of individualized care and attention is something Tamara can provide for Ashby seniors inneed. I strongly encourage you to read more about Tamara on page 3 and to reach out to her, get to know her, and start a conversation about your medical concerns as a senior in Ashby. She is a resource we should all utilize. I promise you won't regret it. Look for more from Tamara in future Senior Scoop newsletters!

ASHBY'S TOWN NURSE VISITS THE COA!

As part of the June 13th COA Meeting, Tamara Bedard, RN, visited the COA office to introduce herself and discuss her role in our community. Ashby is one of the 16 communities that make up the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health. Through this Association, Tamara serves as the "Town Nurse" for all of these communities, including Ashby. She is an RN and the Community Health Manager. Tamara's mission is to provide high quality Public Health Nursing to promote wellness across your lifespan. This includes monthly clinics for health screenings, information and resource referrals, education and outreach, and home visits as needed. The nursing team also works closely with the Massachusetts Department of Public Health to focus on disease prevention. They aim to prevent disease and protect the health of our communities by providing immunization clinics, regular communicable disease investigation and follow-up, and by responding to disease outbreaks.

As Ashby's town nurse, Tamara looks forward to getting to know each of us to best serve and meet the needs of the community. In the future, your COA in coordination with the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health, will be holding well-adult clinics where you may have Tamara check your blood pressure or just talk

about your concerns. She is also available for home visits to make general assessments & help with coordinating care and make referrals to community and other supportive resources.

Tamara and your COA will work together to help Ashby residents age in place and achieve the COA's continued mission: To enhance the quality of life of Ashby senior residents by offering services that strive to promote each person's independence and healthy, successful aging. Tamara is a valuable resource for our town and your COA strongly encourages all Ashby Seniors to utilize her services, wealth of knowledge, and experience.

YOUR INPUT IS NEEDED FOR THE ASHBY HOUSING PRODUCTION PLAN:

A Housing Production Plan (HPP) is a community's proactive and studied means towards developing affordable housing that is in keeping with the Town's own affordable housing policies and preferences. The Plan is not a constructive plan but is more specifically intended to communicate to the state how Ashby can address its affordable housing responsibilities. This plan contains three elements which outline for the state:

- A comprehensive assessment of Ashby's housing needs;
 - Affordable housing goals to meet needs; and
 - Strategies towards achieving goals.

The HPP will be developed through a public process overseen by the Planning Board and administered by Montachusett Regional Planning Commission. Input from all residents, including seniors, is important in developing the plan.

If you wish to participate in developing the plan, please contact the Ashby Planning Board at **386-7981**. Additionally, a survey, and one to two public meetings will be held to solicit comments from residents.


