

Ashby P.D. Tip of the Month:

TELEPHONE SCAM IN OUR AREA!

There have been numerous reports from Unitil involving telephone scams in our area.



Take the following precautions to protect yourself from such a scam:

- **Never** share your personal information (birthday, Social Security number, bank account information, etc.) with an unknown source.
- Customers who are scheduled for disconnection due to nonpayment **receive** written notice that includes the actions they can take to maintain service.
- All Unitil employees carry company-issued identification, and any electrical contractors working with Unitil carry documentation. Customers can always call Unitil or the Ashby Police Department to verify workers' documentation.
- Never wire money to someone you don't know! You cannot get it back.
- Don't assume the name and number on your caller ID are legitimate. Caller IDs can be spoofed.
- **Do not call unexpected numbers or click links** that appear on your cell phone or emails especially those asking for your account information.
